

Welcome to Grammar for Fragments of Western Saga dialect of Japanese

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This is an example project work required to receive two credits from an elective course of SPACE-E program, 'Introduction to Grammar Development', created by the instructor. The work consists of 1) three data sets and 2) grammars for the three stages.

The data set #1 is sentences of the SV pattern of the dialect. The data set #2 is sentences of the SVO pattern. The data set #3 is sentences of SCopular-{N or Adj}.

You can hear the utterances of the sentences by a native speaker, who is the author of the web pages here, and see the grammar to explain the sentences for each stage. The grammar is cumulative. The grammar for those at the third stage includes that for those at the second and first stages, and the grammar for those at the second stage includes that for those at the first stage.
